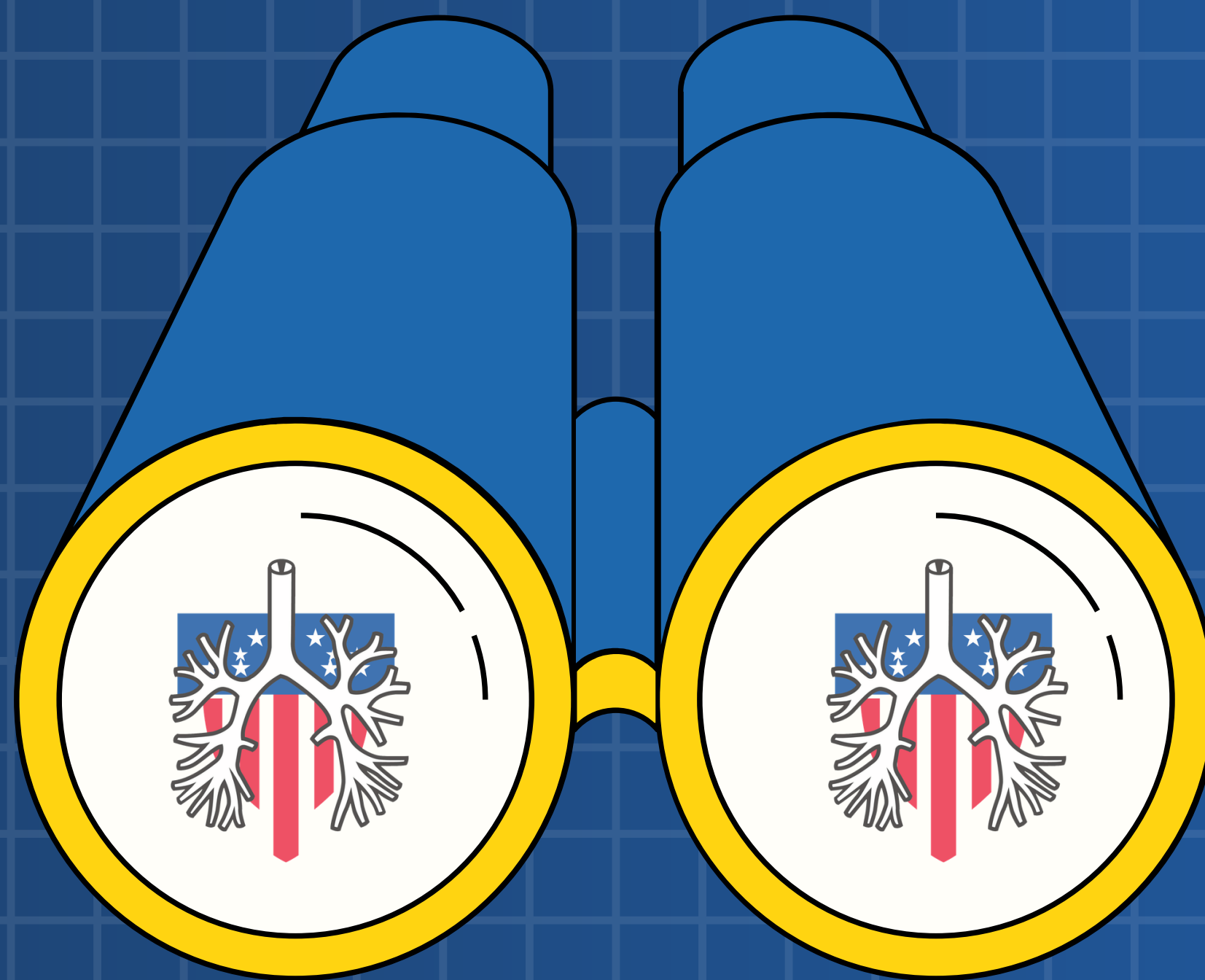
# AABIP JOURNAL CLUB

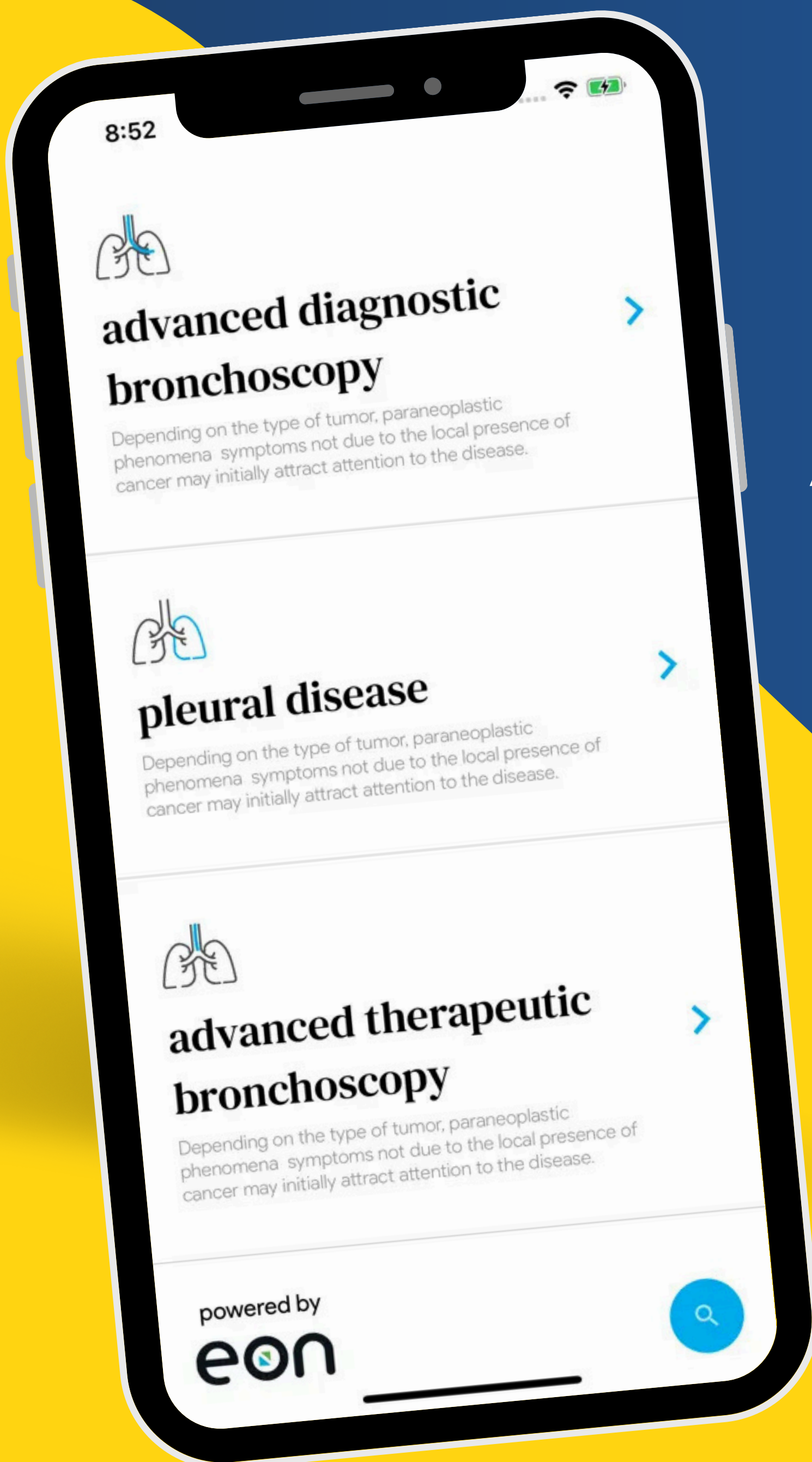
